

SOUTH WALES COLUMN ASSESSMENT OF THE SOUTH WALES	Numerous vehicles observed parking illegally along route raising safety concerns in addition to blocking traffic.	MB to liaise with Lambeth on problems.
Belvedere Rd LONG	Lorries' seen waiting for site access causing blocking of traffic.	MB met with logistics team to raise concerns of vehicles parking and slow management of accessing lorries leading to pedestrian safety concerns.

	TM being moved by pedestrians and Securicor var blocking carriageway	Site operatives have made complaints with taxis dropping rides next to TM. This has been reported. MB asked for a patrol

	Ambush point caused by perpendicular angle of hoarding.	MB to liaise with contractors (Vinci/Bam Nuttall)
	Lorry behaviors raised concerns. Exiting side roads at speed.	MB to email all sites to pass message to all drivers to slow speeds.
Ponton Road	Mass barriers observed around	MP raised issues
	site to have no endcaps. These can catch passer by shins etc	which have been rectified already.

AOB	Exiting vehicles observed driving fast	MB asked PW to liaise with Ponton Rd working group to relay message.
Although there have been some issues raised, the Tideway contractors (Murphys) have taken a positive approach to minimise any issues raised and are cooperating fully with the group and TfL to make changes where required. Speed and traffic management consistency are the priority which will be addressed at the Tideway meeting.		MB has set a meeting with the contractor to action all observations made during the ride.
